As you are aware, on the 16th October we had a Church School's inspection. I am delighted to say that following this inspection the school has been rated as 'Good'. The inspector enjoyed her time with us and was very positive and complimentary about the school. She highlighted that 'Christian values of love, friendship and respect are clearly central to the work and good relationships at this school' and that the 'Robust strategic monitoring cycle ensure that the school is constantly looking to improve for the benefit of the pupils in its care.' The school are selling poppies and other items from the Royal British Legion and these will be available on the playground each morning and from the office at other times.

Thank you to all who bought a book or other item from our book fair. It was lovely to see the children's enthusiasm about the books on offer. We took just under £300 pounds, which means that teachers will now have a small amount of money to spend on books for their classrooms.
