

Year 1 Maths Lesson

Teaching notes for adults:

The learning objectives for today are:

- To be able to place 2-digit numbers on a beaded line.
- To be able to suggest a number between neighbouring multiples of 10.

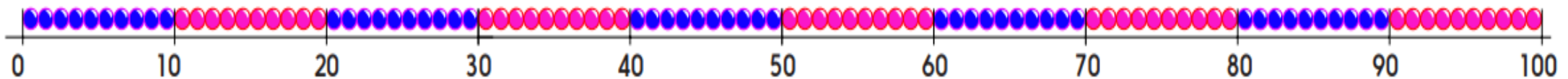
There is an activity and two worksheets for you to do with your child.

What you will need:

- Some paper and a pencil
- 100-bead line (provided below)

Activity:

- Show your child the 100-bead line with multiples of 10 tags (provided below).
- Discuss how we know that the tagged numbers are all multiples of 10 (they all have a zero in the 1s column).
- Write 20 and 30 on two pieces of paper.
- Ask your child to write a number between 20 and 30.
- Discuss if it is nearer to 20 or 30 on the bead line.
- Write another two multiples of 10, e.g. 40, 50 and repeat.
- Repeat several times.

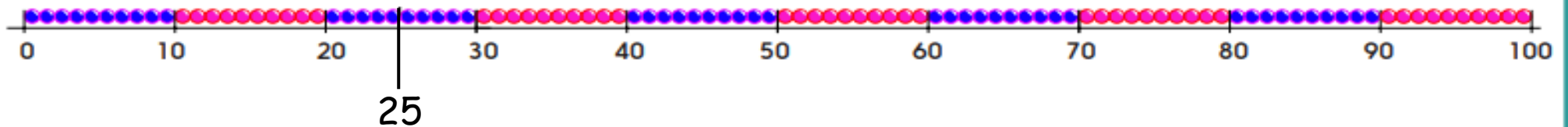
