

Foreign Languages

Our chosen foreign language is French. Language learning starts in year 3 and continues throughout key stage 2. Most of our language teaching is via speaking and listening, with some written learning to reinforce the language skills.

The aims of our language teaching are that children will be able to:

- Listen to the spoken language and show understanding by joining in and responding
- Explore the patterns and sounds of language and link the spelling, sound and meaning of words
- Ask and answer questions; express opinions and respond to those of others
- Speak in sentences, using familiar vocabulary, phrases and basic language structures
- Develop accurate pronunciation and intonation
- Understand basic grammar
- Broaden their vocabulary and develop their ability to understand new words
